Laura N. Gasaway (Lolly) has been Associate Dean since July 2006. She served as Director of the Law Library and Professor of Law from 1985 until 2006. She teaches courses in Copyright Law and Cyberspace Law in the law school and Copyright Law for Librarians in the School of Information and Library Science.

She obtained her B.A. and M.L.S. degrees from Texas Woman's University in 1967 and 1968 respectively. Her J.D. degree is from the University of Houston in 1973. Prior to coming to Chapel Hill, she held the same position at the University of Oklahoma from 1975-84 and at the University of Houston from 1973-75.

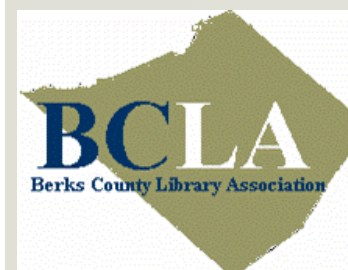
Lolly is a past president of the American Association of Law Libraries and is a Fellow of the Special Libraries Association and has served on and chaired various committees of both associations, including their Copyright Committees. She served on the American Bar Association's Accreditation Committee and on the Council of the Section on Legal Education and Admissions to the Bar. Lolly represented the AAU at the Fair Use Conferences (for the National Information Infrastructure). Lolly was the first virtual scholar in residence at the Center for Intellectual Property, University of Maryland, University College, 2002-03. She is currently co-chair of the Section 108 Study Group for the National Digital Information Infrastructure and Preservation Program and the Copyright Office.

## COPYRIGHT LAW IN THE DIGITAL AGE

This workshop is designed to provide librarians with an overview of the current status of the U.S. copyright law and its impact on library services. Emphasis is on the copyright status of print, audiovisual and electronic information as well as computer programs, databases, electronic journals, the Internet and World Wide Web.

Participants will focus on copyright law basics and learn to evaluate potential uses of copyrighted works in libraries and education and to apply considerations for formulating institutional and organizational copyright policies. Specific provisions of the U.S. Copyright Act, existing guidelines, the TEACH Act and the Section 108 Study recommendations will be reviewed. Recent court decisions relating to infringement, fair use and reproduction of copyrighted works in libraries in both the nonprofit and for-profit sectors and in educational institutions are discussed.
